EDUCATION

Each Activator will complete British Wheelchair Basketball's Activators' Award (e-learning). On successful completion of the course, Inspire a Generation Activators will then be able to facilitate community wheelchair basketball sessions and activities.

TRAINING

Comprehensive induction programme, mentoring and access to online resources for all Inspire a Generation Activators.

COMMUNITY LINKS

The team at British Wheelchair Basketball will work with new Activators to help identify and facilitate links to local/community delivery sites and wheelchair basketball clubs. These links will help IAG Community Activators access equipment and facilities to deliver wheelchair basketball. There are also grants available to support with costs.

Key Activator Responsibilities:

- ✓ To complete the Activators' Award and further training.
- ✓ To plan, lead and review at least six wheelchair basketball activity sessions in your local community / virtually.
- ✓ To promote sessions in your community.
- ✓ To upload sessions and update registers on the BWB membership portal.
- ✓ To have a valid DBS check completed via BWB/Partner.
- ✓ To observe all BWB policies and procedures, including the Safeguarding Policy and Procedures, Code of Conduct and Equal Opportunities Policy.
- ✓ To support new participants to access their local wheelchair basketball clubs.

If you would like to train a group of staff or volunteers to deliver Inspire a Generation through wheelchair basketball sessions, then please get in touch.

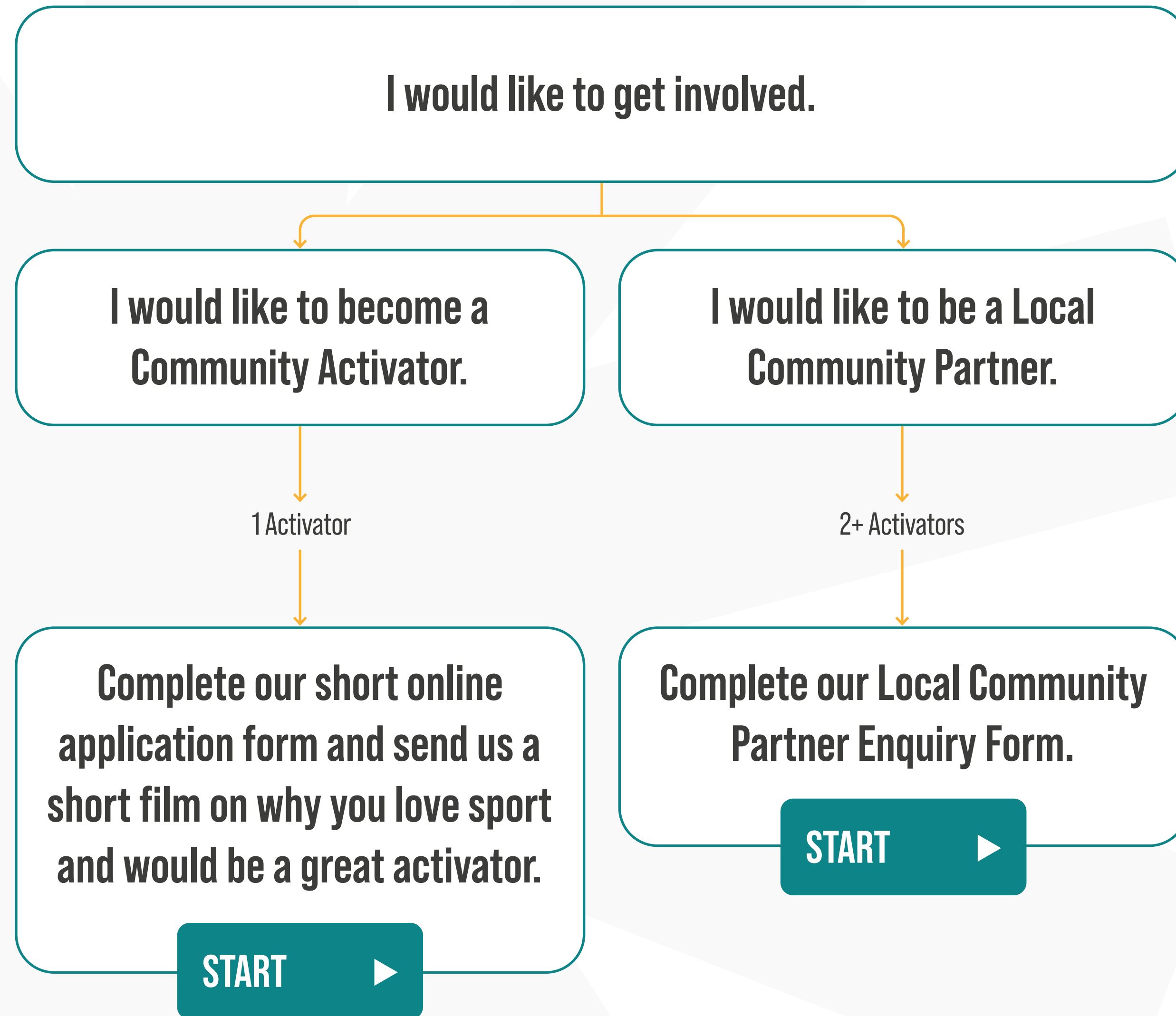
